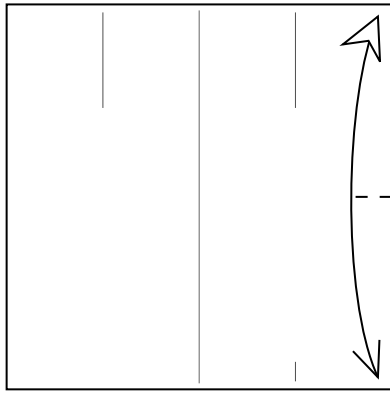


1. Fold in half and unfold.

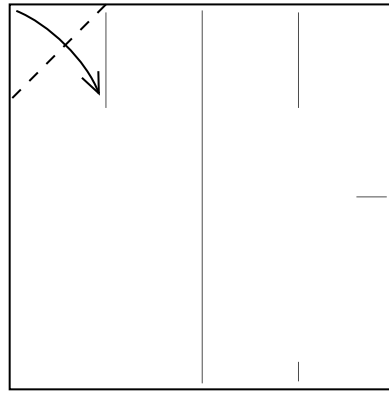


2. Valley fold the edges to the center and unfold, creasing only about the top quarter on the left and right, and a pinch at the bottom on the right only.

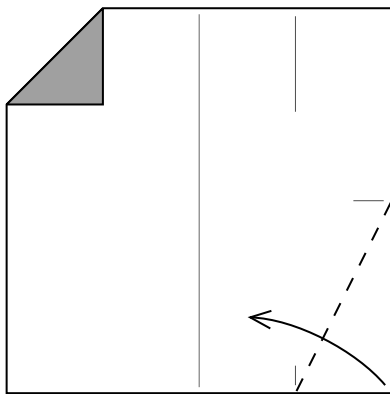




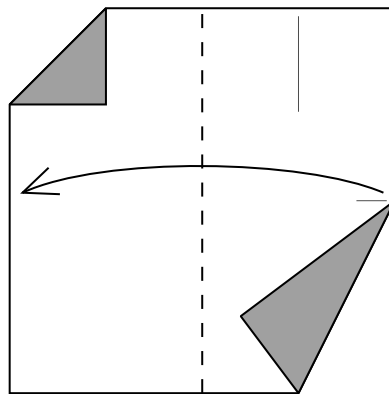
3. Valley fold in half, only creasing a pinch on the right side.



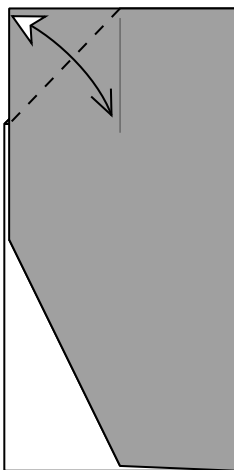
4. Valley fold the top left corner down to the crease.



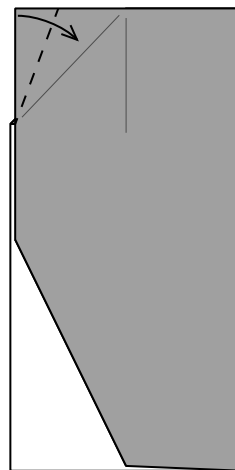
5. Valley fold the bottom right corner so the crease meets the two pinch folds.



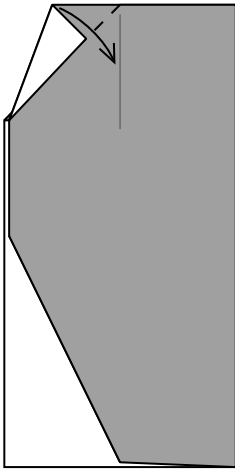
6. Valley fold in half.



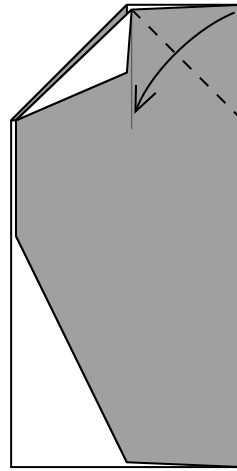
7. Valley fold the top left corner down to the crease and unfold.



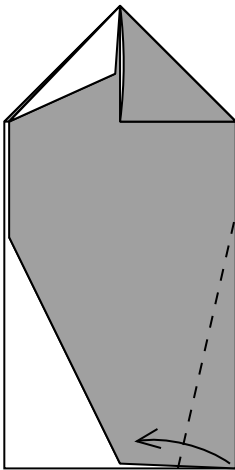
8. Valley fold the top left corner down to the crease made in the previous step.



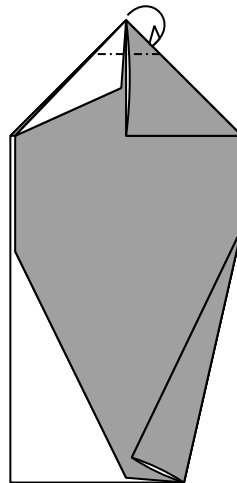
9. Valley fold the top left corner down using the crease made in step 7.



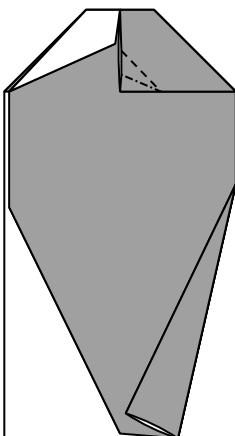
10. Valley fold the top right corner down to lie along the vertical crease.



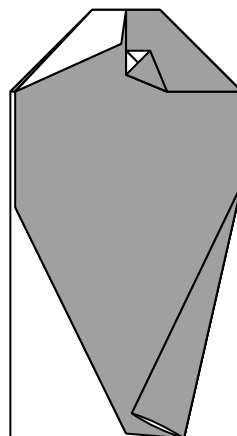
11. Valley fold the lower right corner up. There are no reference points for this fold.



12. Mountain fold the top of the head behind. The crease should be about half-way down the white section.



13. Make a squash fold to form the eye. There are no reference points for this fold.



14. The finished penguin.
